CEBU TAOIST TEMPLE

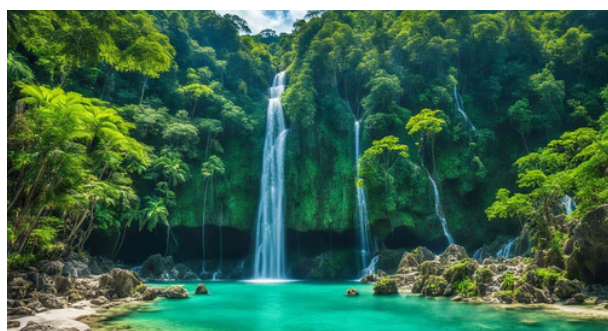
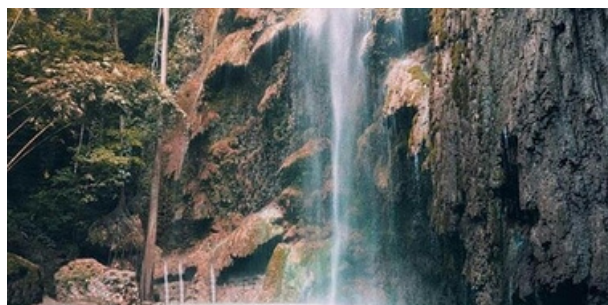

TUMALOG FALLS

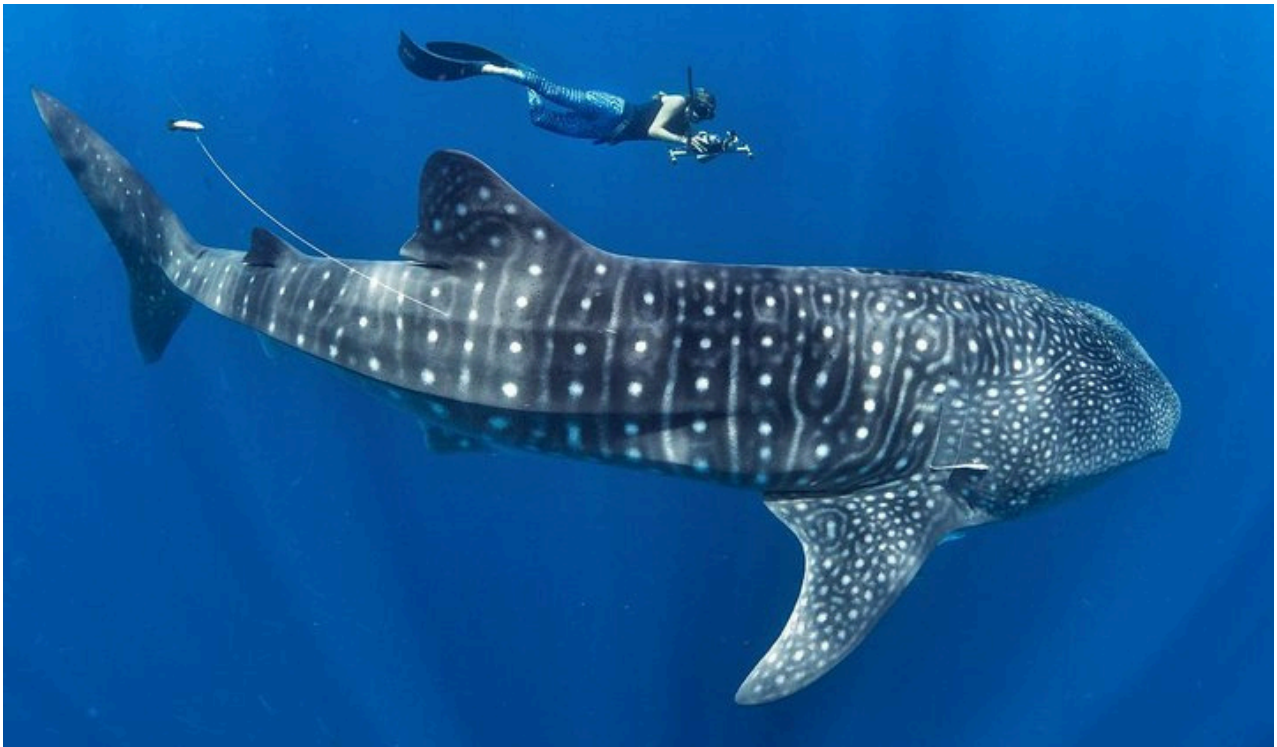
